# What is SRI?

SRI is a reading assessment. The SRI determines your Lexile Reading Level. Your score also determines the level of text you will receive in class.

# SRI Testing

1. Log in to Chrome
2. Go to Jennings Webpage
3. Click on Departments (top of webpage)
4. Click on Technology, then “click here.”
5. Scroll down on left side of page to SRI
6. Click on “SRI College and Career.”

# How to access SRI

1. Use your name strip to log in to SRI. The password is on your slip.
2. Once you finish the SRI, raise you hand so I can record your score.
3. See me for your weekly homework packet. Begin completing the packet.
